## **THURSDAY'S CLOSEST TO PIN KNOCKOUT**

ENTRY: \$100 CASH per player – must be present ready to play on #9 fairway by 7:00 PM

### FORMAT:

- Each player gets one shot from #9 fairway to #18 green
- Contest starts at 135 yards and gradually moves up to 100 yards with each round
- Any shot that misses the green is automatically eliminated
- The ball on the green that is farthest from the flag is eliminated
- If all players in a round miss the green, the round is replayed
- Repeat until only one player is remaining

### PRIZE:

- If less than 10 players, 100% goes to winner
- If 10+ players enter, the runner-up also receives a percentage of the pot
- If a hole-in-one is made at any point, that player is automatically declared the winner

### PARTICIPANTS NEED:

- \$100 Cash Entry
- Clubs to hit shots from ~100-135 yards
- Golf Ball with identifying mark

## **PARI-MUTUEL BETTING – *sponsored by Katz, Sapper & Miller***

**\*\*NEW\*\* Mobile app for placing bets that will provide real time odds and confirmations**

Instructions on how to place bets using the mobile app will be sent on Tuesday, August 2<sup>nd</sup>

Betting will open on Tuesday, August 2<sup>nd</sup> in advance of the tournament

All wagers must then be paid in person with CASH starting at 6:00 PM on Thursday

Note that there is NOT an ATM in the clubhouse

Assistance with using the mobile app will also be available on Thursday evening

## **GIFTS**

- **Players may stop in the pro shop on Thursday evening or anytime on Friday to select a polo and receive their gift bag**
- Players will also have a gift to pick up on Friday evening

## **SPECIAL EVENTS**

### **Closest to Pin Contests - *sponsored by Baird Wealth Management***

- There are closest to pin contests on all par 3s during all 5 rounds

### **\$5,000 Hole-In-One Contest - *sponsored by Baird Wealth Management***

- The first hole-in-one from the Burgundy or Tan tees on #5, #8, #13 & #17 will win \$5,000

### **\$100,000 Hole-In-One Challenge - *sponsored by Banker Investment Group***

- Friday beginning at 7:30 PM 24 players will have a shot at \$100,000
- 151 yard shot from #18 fairway to #9 green
- The 12 par 3 proxy winners from Friday's Rounds 1, 2 & 3 automatically qualify. If same player gets multiple proxies, the highest # round & hole reverts to second place proxy.
- Proxy winners may defer their chance to another player that is not already qualified
- There will be other players that will also have a chance at the shot for \$100,000 through various methods

## **RULES**

- **BURGUNDY Tees unless indicated on your scorecard as TAN or GREEN**
- USGA Rules Govern All Play
- **Bunkers:** Rocks and loose impediments in bunkers may be removed without penalty
- **Out of Bounds:** Defined by white stakes. Penalty for a ball out of bounds is Stroke & Distance
- **Abnormal Course Conditions:** Ground Under Repair: Mulched landscape beds, and areas completely encircled with white lines. Fans around greens are deemed Temporary Immovable Obstructions allowing line of flight relief
- Rules Officials: Greg Foerg, Dan Booher, Jeff Staley & Brent Wills

## **FORMAT**

- The format is Four-Ball match play (2-man best ball) with five 9-hole matches in each flight
- Participants play their own ball throughout and receive 85% of their course handicap
- Strokes for each match are figured off the lowest handicap within the foursome
- Strokes are applied according to the handicapping of each hole on the scorecard
- The lower of each team member's net score counts as the team score for that hole
- Each 9-hole match will have an official scorecard with handicap strokes marked accordingly

## **HAVE FUN and PLAY FAST**

**If you are out of the hole, PICK IT UP and caddie!      Let's Gooooooooooooooooo!!!**

## **SCORING**

- There will be a total of 10 points awarded for each match
- 1 point is awarded for each hole won and ½ point for a tie
- 1 point will be awarded for the winner of the match
- If a match is tied, each team will receive ½ a point
- A maximum of 7 points will be awarded for winning any one match
- A minimum of 3 points will be awarded for any losing match
- The team with the most points in each flight will advance to the Steeplechase Finale
- One random team will be drawn on #13 tee to play in the Steeplechase, teams must be present and ready to play

### **\*\*NEW\*\* JOLLY ROGER FLIGHT**

- Any teams mathematically eliminated from winning their flight after Round 3 on Friday will automatically be entered into the Jolly Roger Flight for Saturday's Rounds 4-5
- The team in the Jolly Roger Flight that scores the most points on Saturday will qualify for the Steeplechase Finale

## **STEEPLECHASE FINALE – Holes #13-18**

- The 12 flight winners, the 1 Jolly Roger flight winner, and 1 random draw all qualify to play in the Steeplechase
- Alternate Shot with each team receiving 50% of their combined team handicap
- Starting on hole #13 one player hits a tee sheet and then teams alternate into the hole
- Player that does not hole out tees off on following hole
- 4 teams eliminated on hole #13
- 3 teams eliminated on holes #14, #15
- 1 team eliminated on holes #16, #17, #18
- Champs determined on hole #18 (replaying #18 if tie, no chip off for champions)
- Elimination Chip-Offs
  - If multiple teams tie to be eliminated, there will be a chip off with the spot determined by a rules official
  - The player that did not hole out attempts the chip shot
  - Competitors in the chip off are to turn away and not watch the other chip shots (gallery to remain quiet)
  - A chip shot that does not come to rest on the green counts but is not measured
  - If chip off ends in a tie (same distance from hole or neither on green), teams alternate players and re-chip
  - The team advancing from the chip off will continue to alternate players (chip counts as a shot)
